R. Mack, Roy, and Hazel Brown Scholarship Awarded by Home Sweet Home Ministries

Home Sweet Home Ministries announces the R. Mack, Roy, and Hazel Brown Scholarship Program. Under the Program, at least two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded to individuals who meet the scholarship criteria and are selected by Home Sweet Home Ministries selection committee.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- 1. <u>Educational Experience</u>. Each applicant must be a high school senior, high school graduate, or have earned a high school equivalency.
- 2. <u>Minimum Grades</u>. Each applicant must have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on an unweighted 4.0 scale. Each applicant must provide an official transcript as evidence of these grade requirements.
- 3. <u>College Attendance</u>. The applicant must be reasonably expected to attend a Qualifying Institution (defined below), and must actually plan to do so during the next academic year (for which scholarships will be paid.)
- Completion of Application. The applicant must complete the entire application required by Home Sweet Home Ministries, including providing all documentation requested in the application or otherwise requested by Home Sweet Home Ministries.
- 5. <u>Prohibited Family Relationship</u>. Each applicant must <u>not</u> have a family or business relationship with any director or officer of Home Sweet Home Ministries.
- 6. <u>Residence</u>. Each applicant must be a resident of the State of Illinois, excluding residents of Cook County.
- 7. Religion. Each applicant must be a recognized adherent of the Christian faith.
- 8. <u>Motivation</u>. Each applicant must demonstrate motivation as well as academic and leadership potential.
- 9. "Qualifying Institution" means a vocational school, college, or university that is a US based educational organization exempt from federal income tax under either Code 115 or Code 501(c) (3) and that is described in Code 170 (b) (1) (A) (ii). For graduate school, eligibility includes any university in the world.

Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the Qualifying Institution, not the student.

Applications must be received by Home Sweet Home Ministries no later than April 1, 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.
